Who had the first meeting in the AV, Lancaster or Palmdale? And when and where was it? As often happens in historical research, the picture isn't entirelly clear. A recently obtained digital copy of a 1948 Grapevine has the following notice: "New groups registered

New groups registered with General-Headquarters during January were: CALIFORNIA — Costa Messa Lancaster, Dis Angeles (South Broadway Group), San Francisco (Seven Sessi Group) CONNECTICUT — Bridgeport (Black Rock Group) FLORIDA — Bradenton, Hollywood, Wauchala (Hardee County Group) ILINOIS — Ottawa, Rock Island

However, no Lancaster meeting appears in the Los Angeles area Central Office directory until 1950. It could very well be that a Lancaster group registered with New York in 1948 but didn't register with Los Angeles Central Office until 1950. #### This Matter of Honesty

"Only God can fully know what absolute honesty is. Therefore, each of us has to conceive what this great ideal may be – to the best of our ability

"Fallible as we all are, and will be in this life, it would be presumptions to suppose that we could ever really achieve absolute honesty. The best we can do is to strive for a better quality of honesty.

"Sometimes we need to place love ahead of indiscriminate 'factual honesty.' We cannot, under the guise of 'perfect honesty,' cruelly and unnecessary hurt others. Always one must ask, 'What is the best and most loving thing I can do?' " *Letter by Bill W. 1966*
